

Cashless catering: Student Information

- Cashless catering will be launched on Monday 9 December.
- Letters will be ready to go home on Monday 2 December, telling parents how to load funds onto student's catering account. Remember to hand the letter to your parents and remind parents to load the funds.

- ❖ From 9 December one of the catering tills will be accepting cash (for those students who have not been registered and scanned for the biometric system or if parents have not activated their account and loaded funds) as well as being available for biometric transactions; the other till will be for biometric transactions only.
- The IOU slip system will not be available from Monday 9 December.
- Students who receive free school meals will need to make sure that they go through a till and scan their thumbs, as everyone else. A free school meal entitles the student to a main course and dessert only (drinking water is available from the water jugs).
- Please be patient it is a new system for everyone.
