Free School Meals

Did you know that for children eligible to receive free school meals the simple act of registering to receive them means that the School receives extra money? The School uses an online system for the processing of applications for free school meals. Please go to https://myfreeschoolmeals.com/ and click on "Apply". Once you have completed the online application and your eligibility has been confirmed the School will be notified. Please allow five working days from the submission of your application for your child to receive the entitlement in the Dining Hall.

The daily allowance for free school meals at Bristol Free School is £2.50. This can be spent at breakfast (between 8.00 am and 8.20 am) at morning break or at lunchtime. This sum allows for the purchase of food only. Drinking water is freely available in the Dining Hall and at other places in the School. If your child wishes to purchase other drinks in the Dining Hall, eg fruit juice, milk shakes then they will need to pay for this, using the School's cashless catering system. If the daily allowance is not used in any one day it does not transfer to the next day. Please note that you need to apply for free school meals on an annual basis. Parents/carers of students in Years 8, 9 and 10 who received free school meals last year need to re-apply (using the system above) during the next week to ensure that their child does not miss out from the end of September.
